This initiative highlighted the college's commitment to nurturing compassionate healthcare professionals and contributing to the welfare of the community.








SSGP Induction Programme










Blood Donation Camp (Day 3)

Contact Lenses That Deliver Drugs for Eye Conditions

Contact lenses are primarily used to correct vision problems like refractive errors, keratoconus, etc. However, they are also commonly used for cosmetic reasons, like enhancing the colour of normal eyes. Now a piece of good news comes from the University of Waterloo, Canada researchers, who developed 3D-printed hydrogel-loaded contact lenses that deliver medication continuously while worn.

The silicone-based hydrogel is durable and

flexible and can encapsulate drugs like amoxicillin, maintaining stability for over a month. This innovation could replace traditional eye drops, improving treatment effectiveness and convenience for patients with eye conditions. The team of researchers – which spans Waterloo's Department of Chemistry and its School of Optometry and Vision Science – created a new type of hydrogel that can deliver drugs to patients with various eye issues when 3D printed onto a contact lens.

Hydrogel, a type of gel that can retain significant volumes of water, is silicone-based and can help control the amount of medication a person would need, continuously delivering it as long as the contact lens is worn.

Using these hydrogel-loaded contact lenses could help physicians reduce pain and the number of times the patient has to apply the drug, as the medication is delivered during normal contact lens wear.

"This concept is much more efficient and easier to comply with than using eye drops, which are often difficult to insert for patients and need frequent administration over the day," said Lyndon Jones, a Waterloo professor in the School of Optometry and Vision Science and director of the Centre for Ocular Research & Education.

With their recently filed patent, the researchers aim to expand the use of contact lenses for treating eye illnesses.


National Reading Day


Journal Presentation
